

Week 5 - Craft - Growing in our Faith



Growing in God





- 1. Give each child the "Growing in God" flower template and have them cut it out.
- 2. Glue down the center circle of the flower, as well as the stem and the leaves.
- 3. On each "petal" of the flower, have them write one way that they can grow in their relationship with God.
- 4. Cut along the dotted lines on the flower to create flaps.
- Beneath each petal, have the students do a self-reflection and rate how often or how consistently they do each thing that they wrote.
- 6. Use the scale 1 = rarely and a 5 = everyday/very often.


Suggested ways to Grow in God:

- Pray
- •Read the Bible daily
- Memorize Bible verses
- Attend church regularly
- •Talk with others about God
- Obey God and those in authority
- Confess your sins
- Worship God

On the bottom of the page or on the back, have the students write a prayer of commitment to the Lord to increase in the areas they scored themselves low on.







Growing faith leaf collage

You will need:

- Construction paper
- Glue
- Scissors
- Felt, foam, or decorative leaves
- Leaves (real)
- Pens/decorative material
- Seeds (optional)



Procedure:

- 1. Draw or cut and paste a "tree like" image onto the construction paper.
- 2. Add a caption (printed or written) with the verse and a fun pun like "be-leaf God's promises" or "God will grow your faith" or "God will not LEAF you!"
- 3. Add extra leaves: glue on paper or foam leaves, find real leaves outside, or draw leaves.
- 4. Use creativity and artistry to decorate the collage: choose from leaf designs, add some seeds, throw on some glitter, incorporate colour...whatever makes it fun and unique to each child.
