TAPE RESIST EASTER CROSS CRAFT

This is a great craft it just a little bit of prep, but makes a really pretty art project.

Supplies:

- White card stock
- Painters tape
- Watercolours

We choose to do a rainbow for our Easter Cross Craft, but encourage kids to get creative and express their own style.

Directions:

Age: This is a great art project for all ages. You could also use finger paints.

1. Using masking tape make a cross on a piece of white card stock.

2. Using watercolours paint at least the area around the cross. Try not to get the paper too wet, it will make removing the tape harder.

3. You want to pull the tape off when it is barely dry. Watercolours dry pretty quickly, so you should be able to remove shortly after the project is finished. If it starts to pull the paper, try pulling from a different angle.



Pre-schoolers love making this Easter cross craft. It is a great way to talk about the resurrection.

2. **RESURRECTION CRAFT FOR EASTER**

"He has risen!" Mathew 28:6. That's what Easter is all about. Here is a simple craft to do with your kids to help them remember the reason we celebrate Easter.



SUPPLIES FOR A RESURRECTION CRAFT

You'll need: Scissors, a split pin, colouring supplies, and template below.

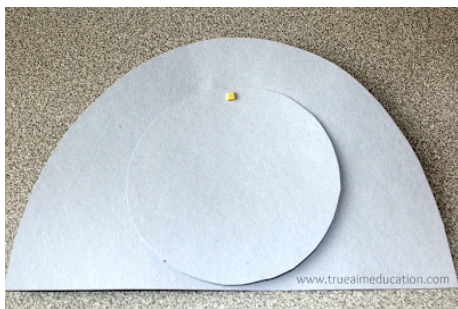
You have two choices:

1. You can use coloured construction paper or,
2. You can print it out on white paper and allow your children to colour a scene around the tomb. Older children like to do this because they can draw animals and people that have come to see Jesus.

To make our "tomb", we first coloured our picture of Jesus.

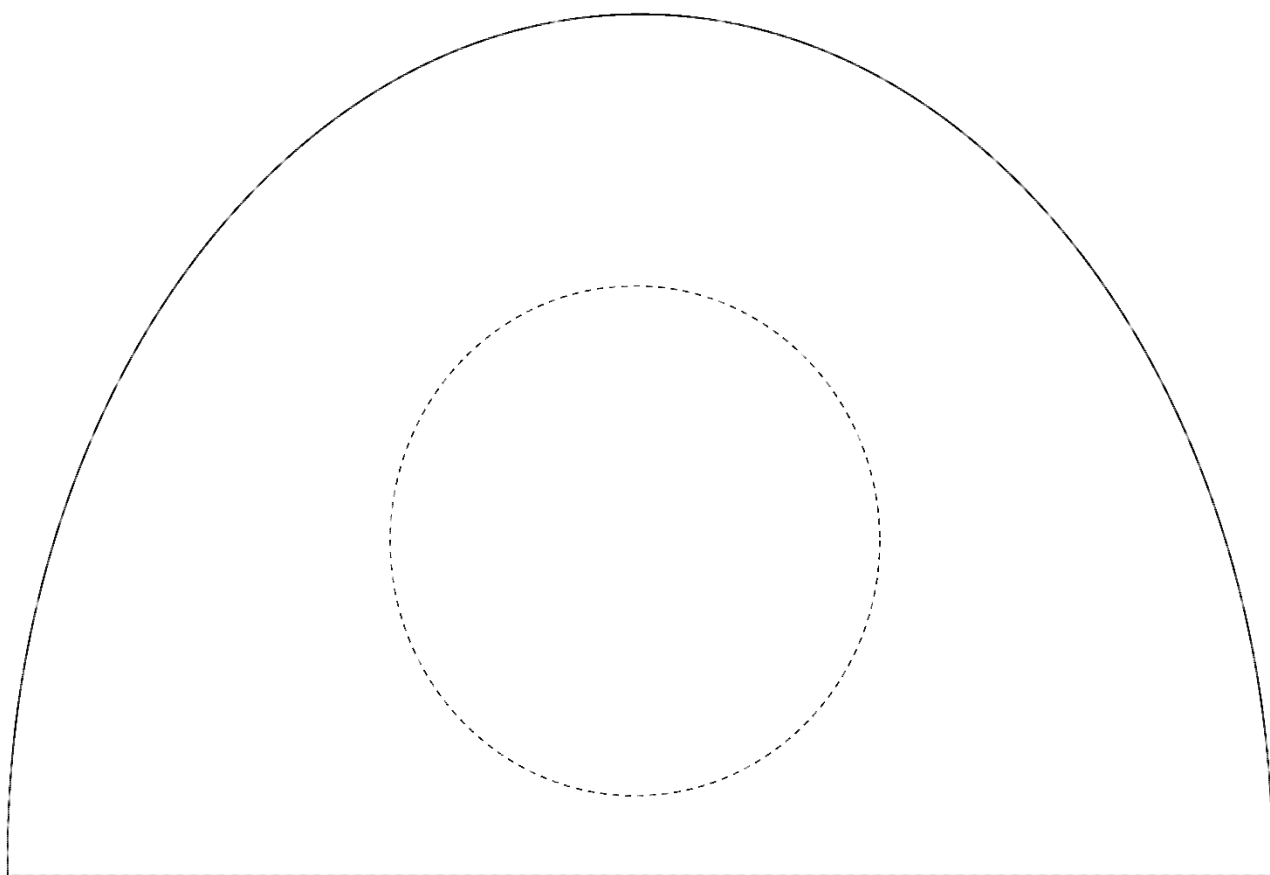
Help the children cut out the hole in the middle of the tomb. Then, we cut Jesus' picture out and taped it to the back. Remember to score your paper for the split pin so you can "roll away the stone".

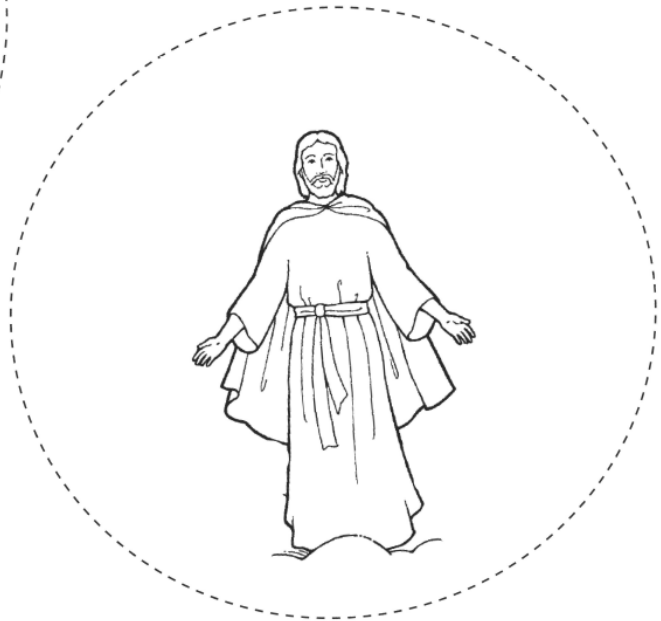
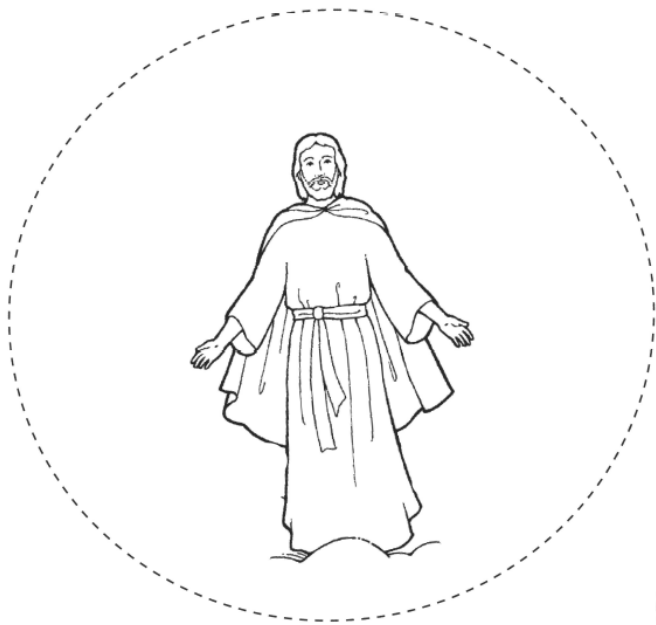
Place the extra circle over the hole of the tomb and fasten it with a brad.



After the craft talk about the importance of Jesus rising from the dead. Apart from Jesus' being born, it is the most important event in the history of Christianity.

3. EASTER SUNCATCHER CRAFT - GOLGOTHA



Cut **two sets** of construction paper borders and scene.



Stick **one set** to the sticky side of contact paper.



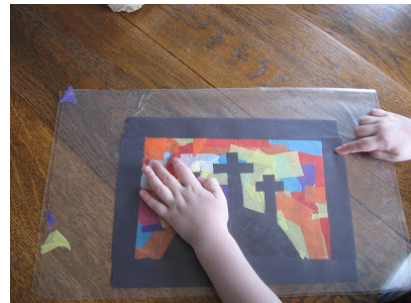
Cover with tissue paper.



Glue the second set over the contact paper, lined up with the first. This step is optional, but it makes the suncatcher look pretty from both sides.



Cover with contact paper - sticky side in.



Trim



Tape it to a window.
