Craft - Parable of the Two Builders





TWO HOUSES


You will need:

- heading
- construction paper
- 6 craft sticks
- glue
- rock pattern contact paper (or grey / brown construction paper)
- craft sand (or sand / dirt)



Directions:

- print and cut the heading
- cut the contact paper into approximately 4cm by 12cm rectangles. (If you use construction paper, cut it to the same size, then crumple and flatten it out to give it a more "rock like" texture.)
- glue the heading to the construction paper ahead of time
- glue the contact paper/construction paper to the bottom left side of
- coloured paper
- put sand to the bottom right side
- glue four craft sticks, in the shape of a house, on the rock
- break two craft sticks, and glue them randomly over the sand





The wise man built his house on the rock. When I obey I am like the wise man.



When I disobey I am like the foolish man.

The foolish man built his house on the sand

SAND ART:

- 1. Use a large piece of heavy stock paper
- 2. Use GLUE to write words from today's lesson such as DON'T BUILD YOUR HOUSE ON THE SAND, or YOUR HOUSE BUILT ON THE SAND WILL FALL, etc.
- 3. Sprinkle SAND (coloured sugar or coconut) on the glue and allow to dry. Sprinkling the sand on the glue words will be easier if done outside or over a large trash bucket, so there will be less clean up.



BUILDING A WISE CHAIN:

- 1. Cut several strips of construction paper about 3cm x 15cm
- 2. Then write on each strip the ways to be WISE about things that Jesus has taught us
- 3. Loop strips together to form a wise chain



ROCK PAINTING:

- Let children pick out several smooth rocks and use markers or paints to write WISE IDEAS to please GOD
- 2. These could be placed on a kitchen table as decoration, or on top of a television, or on top of a piano or a coffee table, etc. as a reminder to make wise decisions for God
