Colour, cut out and assemble mobile

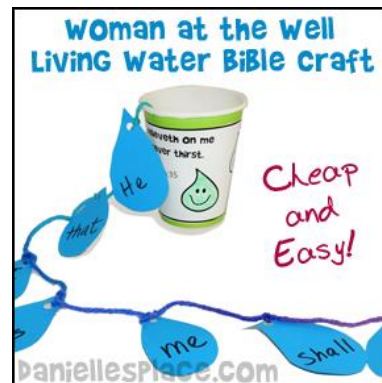




# CUP OF LIVING WATER CRAFT

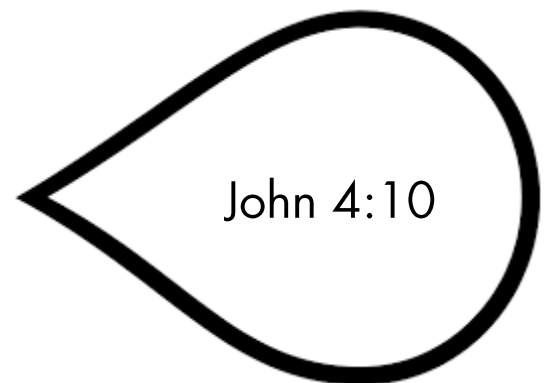
## What you will need:

- White Paper
- Paper Party Cups
- Crayons or Coloured Paper
- Scissors
- Hole Punch
- Blue Card Stock
- Yarn

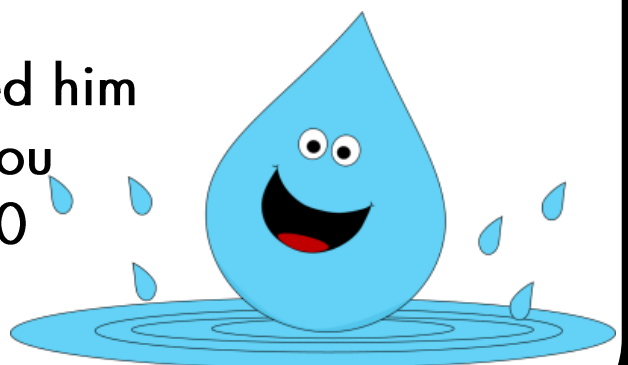


## What to do:

1. Cut water drop shapes from blue card stock (or colour) so that they fit inside the cup.
2. Punch holes at the top of each water drop.
3. String the water drops in order on the string tying each water drop to the string before they add another water drop.
4. Have your children colour the cup and write the Bible verse on one side. Punch a hole in the bottom of the cup and string the yarn through the hole. Tape the string to the bottom of the cup.
5. Paste rectangular label of verse on outside of cup

## DOOR HANDLE HANGER

1. Print on cardstock
2. Colour
3. Cut-out & hang on your door handle



## LAVA LAMPS

Make a lava lamps from empty screw top bottles. We filled them a third full of cooking oil, added food colouring and glitter and then filled them almost to the top with water. On the side write **Jesus is living water**.

### You will need:

- Plastic water bottle
- Cooking Oil
- Stickers (optional)
- Glitter or food colouring (optional)
- Alka-seltzer tablet (optional)



### Procedure:

1. Fill the water bottle about a third of the way with water
2. Carefully pour oil into the remainder of the bottle, until almost full.
3. If desired, add a few drops of food colouring and/or glitter for extra decoration.
4. For extra "living water" fun, add an Alka-Seltzer tablet, broken into pieces.
5. Tightly screw the cap onto the bottle (hot glue may be helpful). Decorate the outside with stickers, if you like, and a verse caption. Shake around (carefully) to watch the "living water" move and separate!



# WOMAN AT THE WELL SPINNING STORY

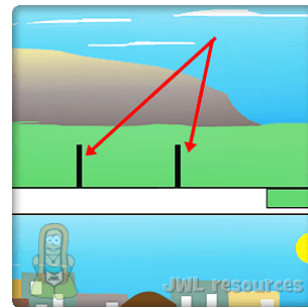
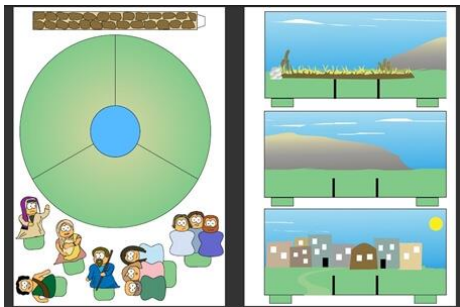
## You will need:

- pair of scissors
- glue
- two pages of the printout. (Do not allow your printer to stretch the template) Colour & B&W template available



## Method:

1. Start by cutting out everything, be careful to completely cut out the black slits for the well. Making these wide will help the well sit in place more smoothly.



2. Fold the small rectangular glue tabs forward and then simply glue the sides together up to the slits for the well. The well itself has a glue tab to show it's size and should easily slip into the slits cut.



3. Attach to the base using the lines as a position guide. The character tabs do not need to be folded flush and are then glued onto the base anywhere in the correct section. The 2 crowd parts go with the houses, the woman is alone at the well, and the three disciples (Simon Peter with black hair, James and John looking more Jewish) are with the wheat field.



4. Finally add text. Stick the text to the ground or add a tab and have it standing up.
