

# Mother's Day Craft

## 1. Give Mum a Hand:

Children outline their hand on a piece of construction paper. Have them decorate the paper and write down something that they love about their mum on the bottom. Then give the paper to mum.

## 2. Connect the Dots:

Children draw a picture of their mum on a sheet of construction paper. Around that picture, have them make 5 to 10 dots with finger paint. Beneath each dot have them write something they love about their mum. Afterwards, have the students draw a line from each dot to their mum's picture.

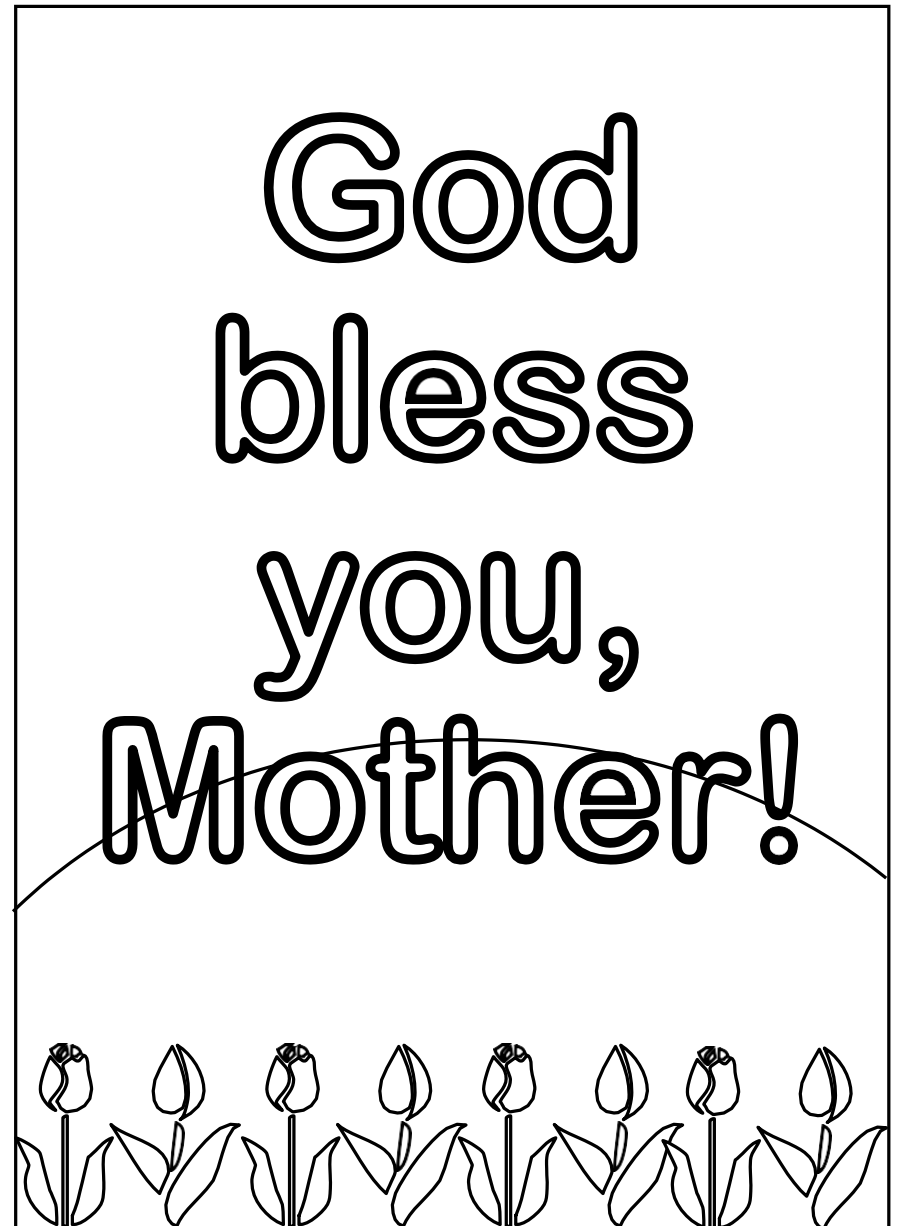
## 3. Mother's Day Bookmark:

Children cut out a bookmark (2.5" x 11") from card stock. Then, with different colours of ribbon that they can glue to the cardstock. This beautiful craft will remind mums of their children's love every time they open scripture.

## 4. Window Heart:

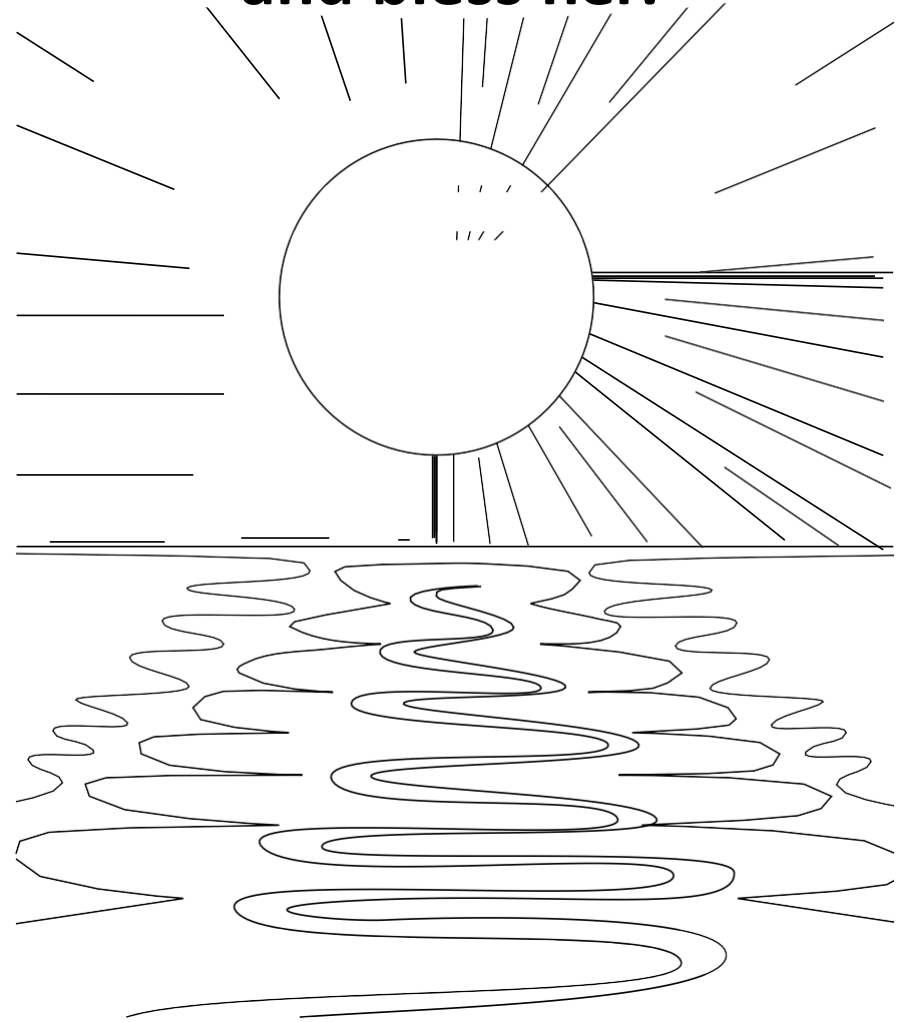
Children fold a sheet of cardstock in half and then cut out a half teardrop on the crease. This will form a heart-shaped cut-out when the card stock is opened up. On the back of the paper, have children glue different sheets of tissue paper across the heart cut out. Then punch a hole in the top of the cardstock. Have the children tell their mum to hang this in front of a window where the sunlight will illuminate the heart.

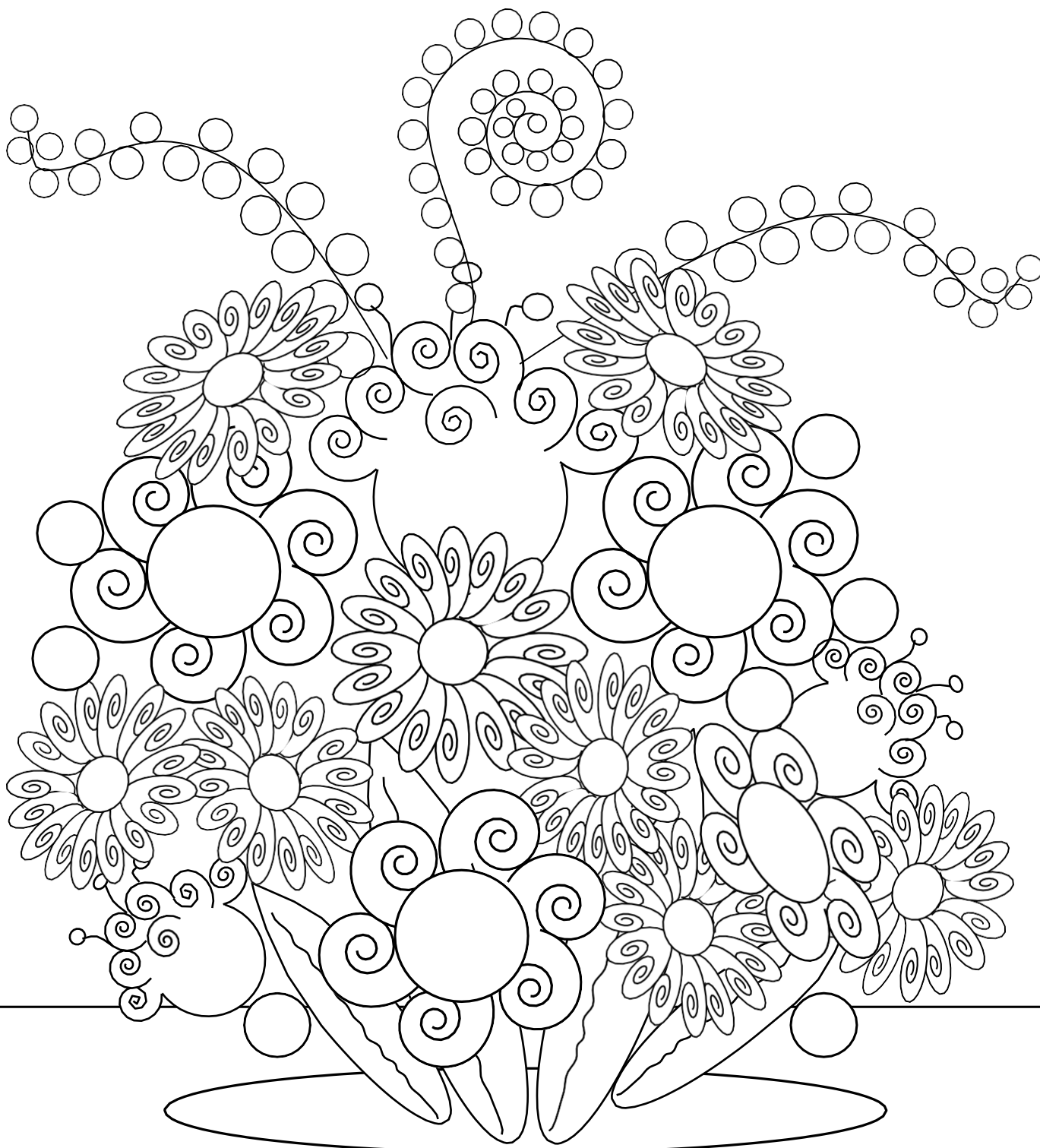
