

## COTTON CLOUD

Use a paper plate to make a large cloud shape and add wisps of cotton on that cloud with glue. Write today's Bible verse on the cloud and hang it from the ceiling.

## BRIGHT SHINING FACES

Use construction paper, markers and many various smiling and happy faces for the children. Write today's Bible verse in the middle of the paper and then decorate with happy face stickers all around the border of the paper.

## SUNSHINE PLATE

Use a paper plate and markers to colour yellow and to glue yellow thin strips of paper all around the edge of the plate to represent the sun's rays. Then draw happy faces on their sunshine plates and hole punch the top of the sunshine plate and add yarn or string so this sunshine craft can be hung on a wall to remind children of today's lesson.

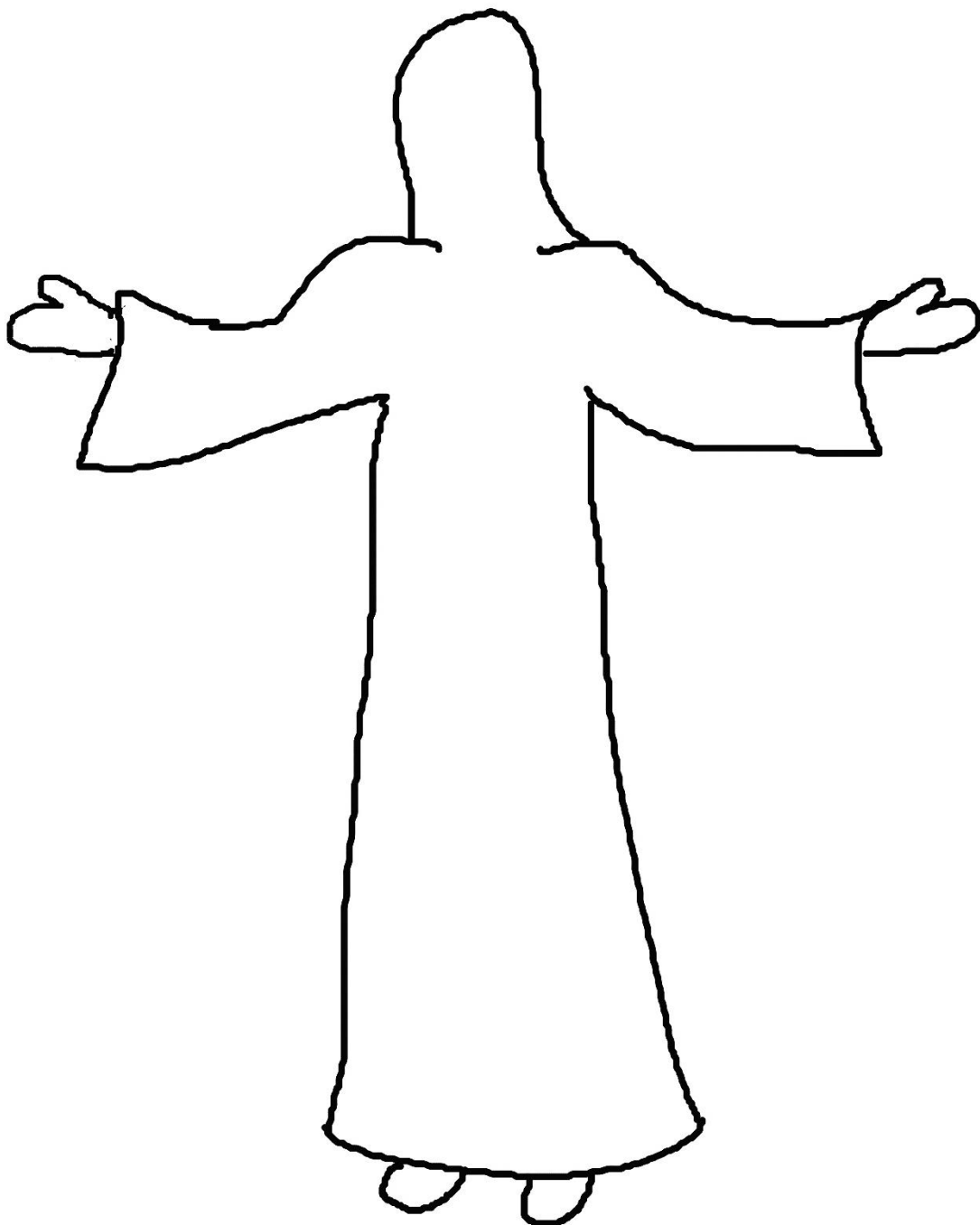
## THE TRANSFIGURATION - SIMPLE 'STRING ART'

### Materials Needed

- coloured card stock
- glitter paper
- oil pastels (yellow & white)
- pen



- glue
- scissors
- paper towel
- outline of Jesus





### Method:

- on the back of the glitter paper trace the outline of Jesus, then cut out
- on the sheet of coloured card stock, use yellow oil pastel (or chalk). Starting at the centre of the page, draw several lines going from the centre out to the edges of the paper
- use the paper towel, to rub (or smear) the crayon to give it a fuzzy look
- draw a few more lines with the white oil pastel (or chalk) and rub it to blend
- glue one Jesus silhouette onto the centre
- the bible verse may also be written on the page if desired



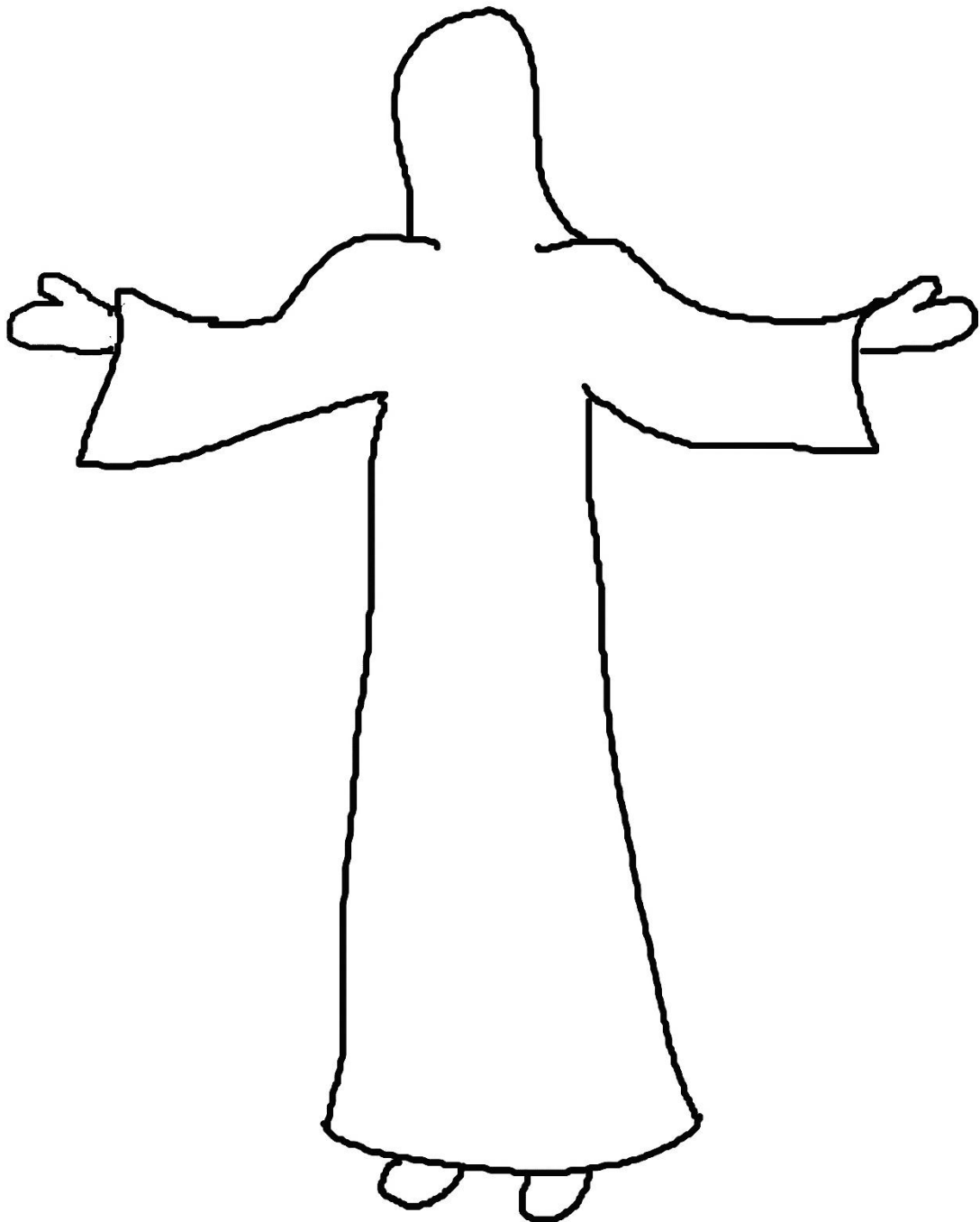
# THE TRANSFIGURATION - STRING ART

## Materials Needed

- foam sheet
- glitter paper
- craft needle
- pen



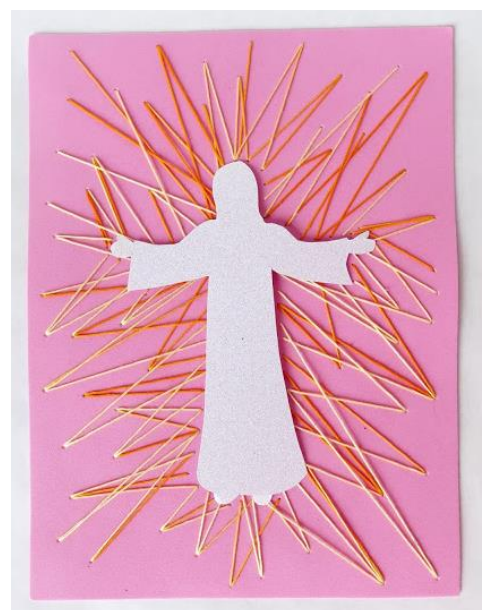
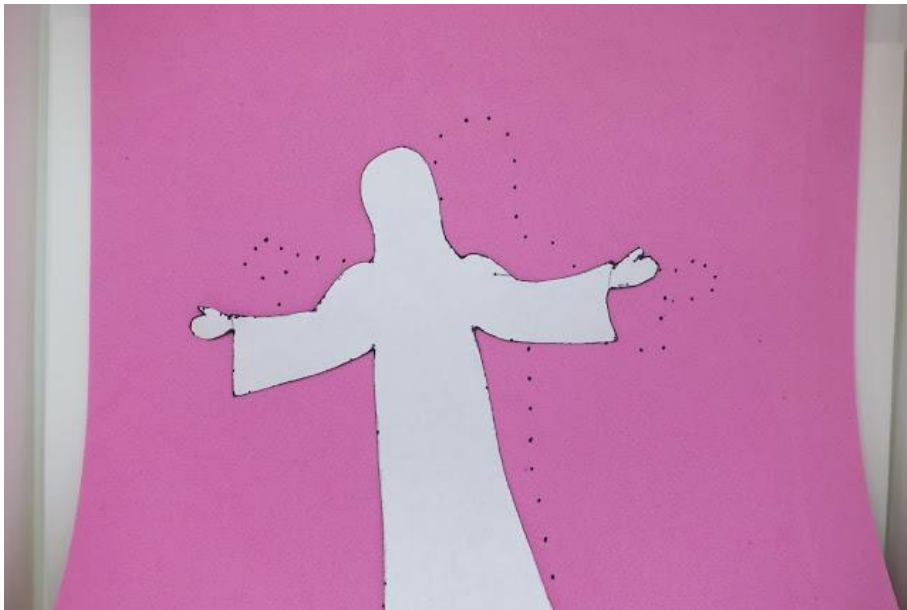
- glue
- scissors
- yellow embroidery thread or sting
- outline of Jesus





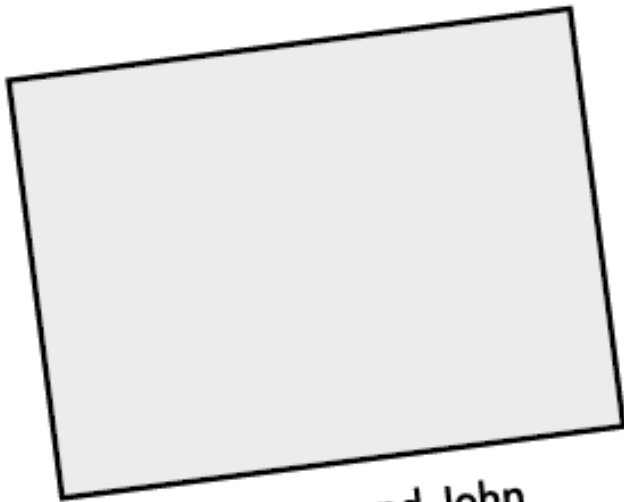
### Method:

- on the back of the glitter paper trace the outline of Jesus, then cut out
- on the back of a foam sheet trace the silhouette of Jesus with dots, as shown
- next add some random dots, some along the edges and some closer in, all the way around
- thread the needle with a long strand of thread. Using the dots for needle placement, stitch from the silhouette dots to the surrounding dots. When one strand ends, tie a new strand to it until the entire picture is covered as pictured below.
- glue one Jesus silhouette onto the centre
- the bible verse may also be written on the page if desired

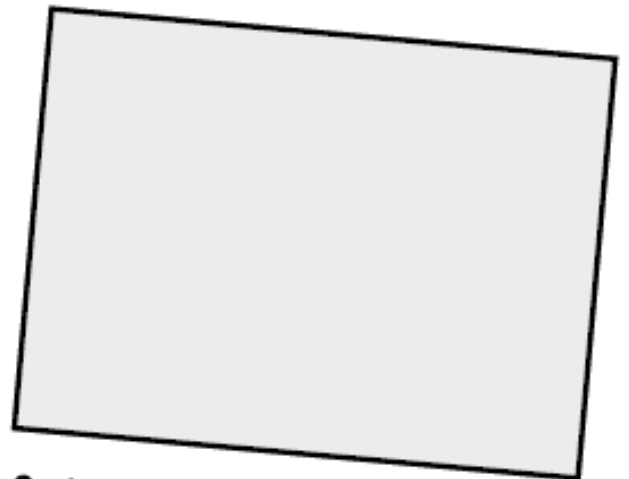


# The Bright Light on the Mountain

3. Two very important men who had lived long ago were inside the light with Jesus.



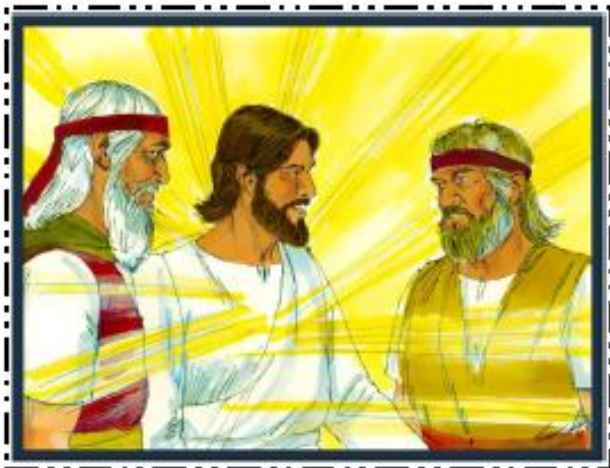
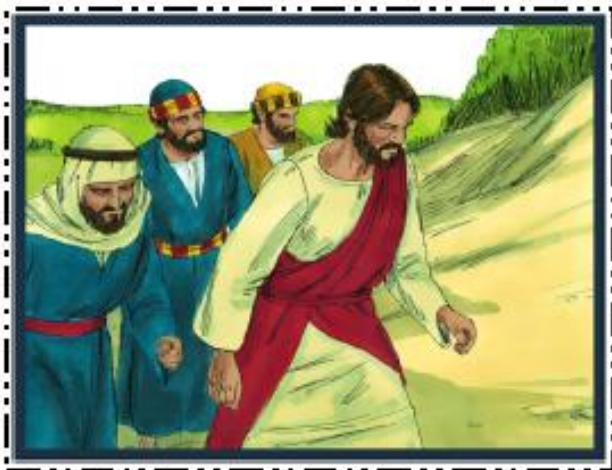
4. A big cloud came down on the mountain and Peter, James and John heard the voice of God coming from the cloud.
