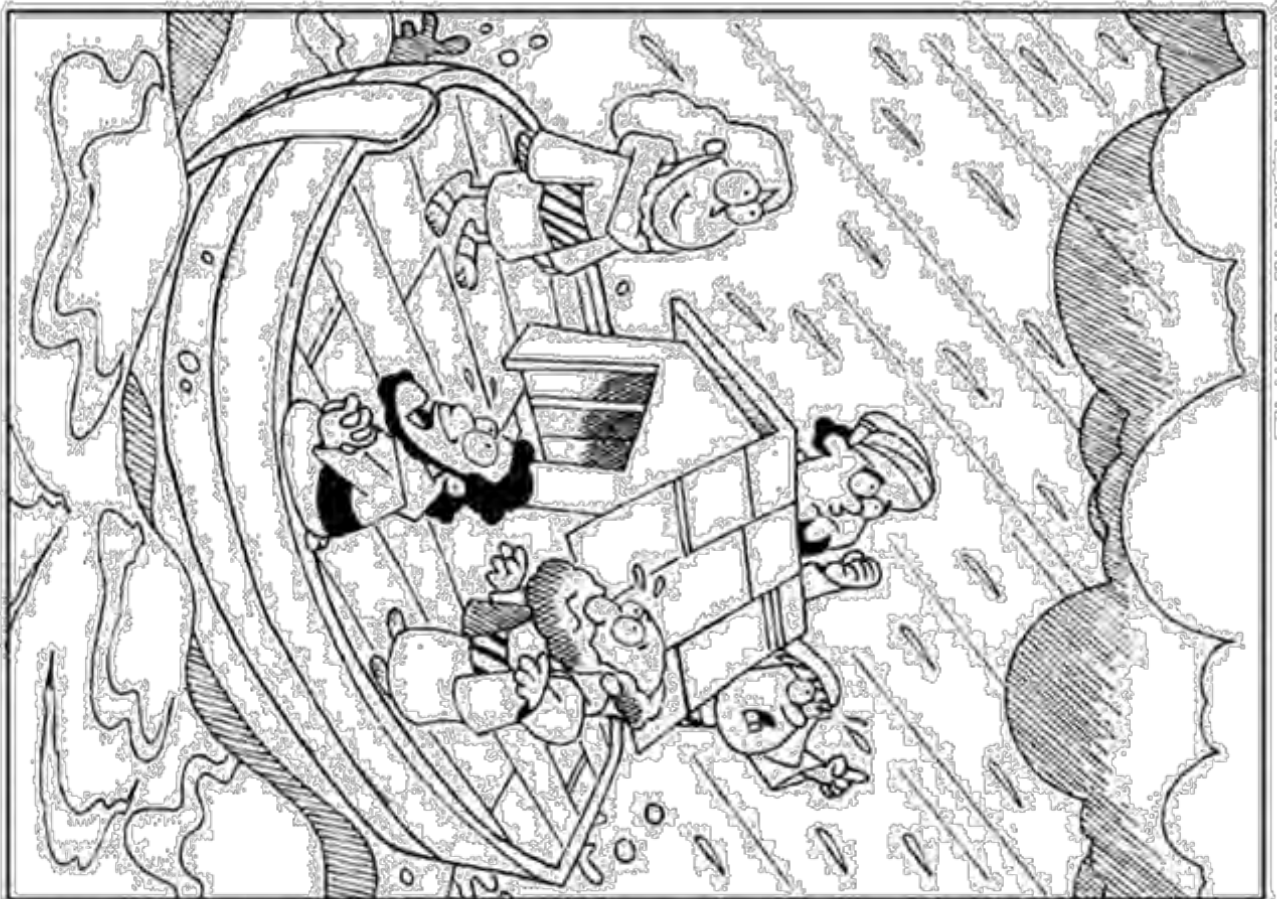
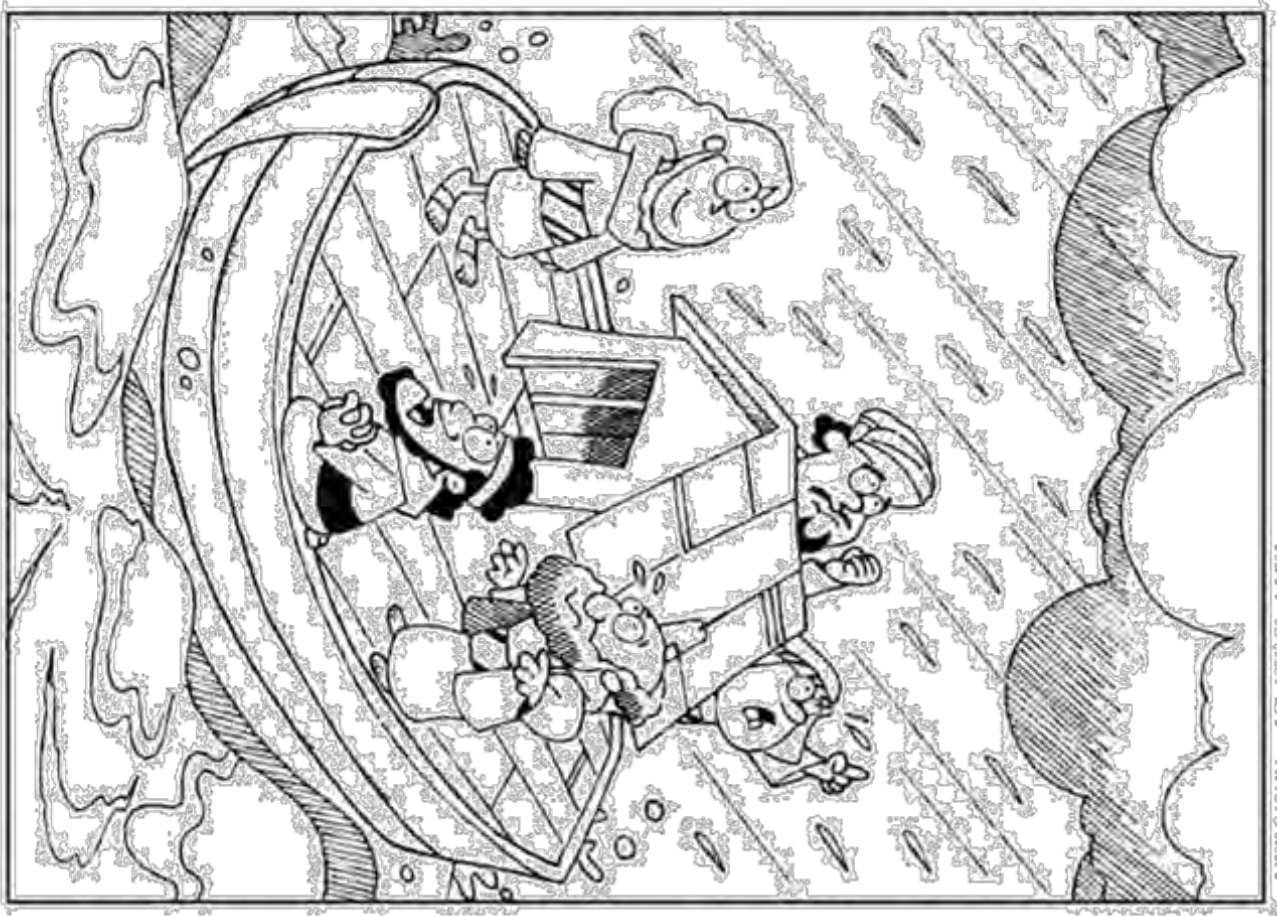

Spot the Difference

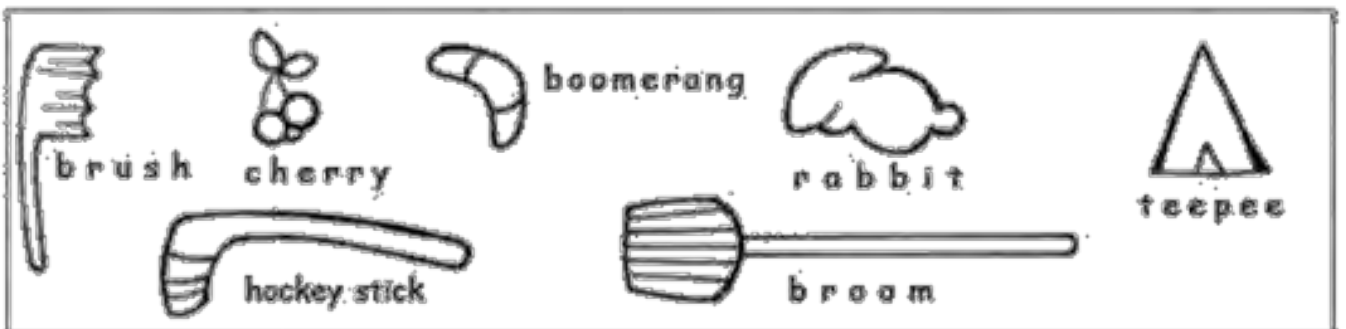
There are 7 differences in the pictures. How many differences can you find?

Jesus Calmed the Storm Match Game

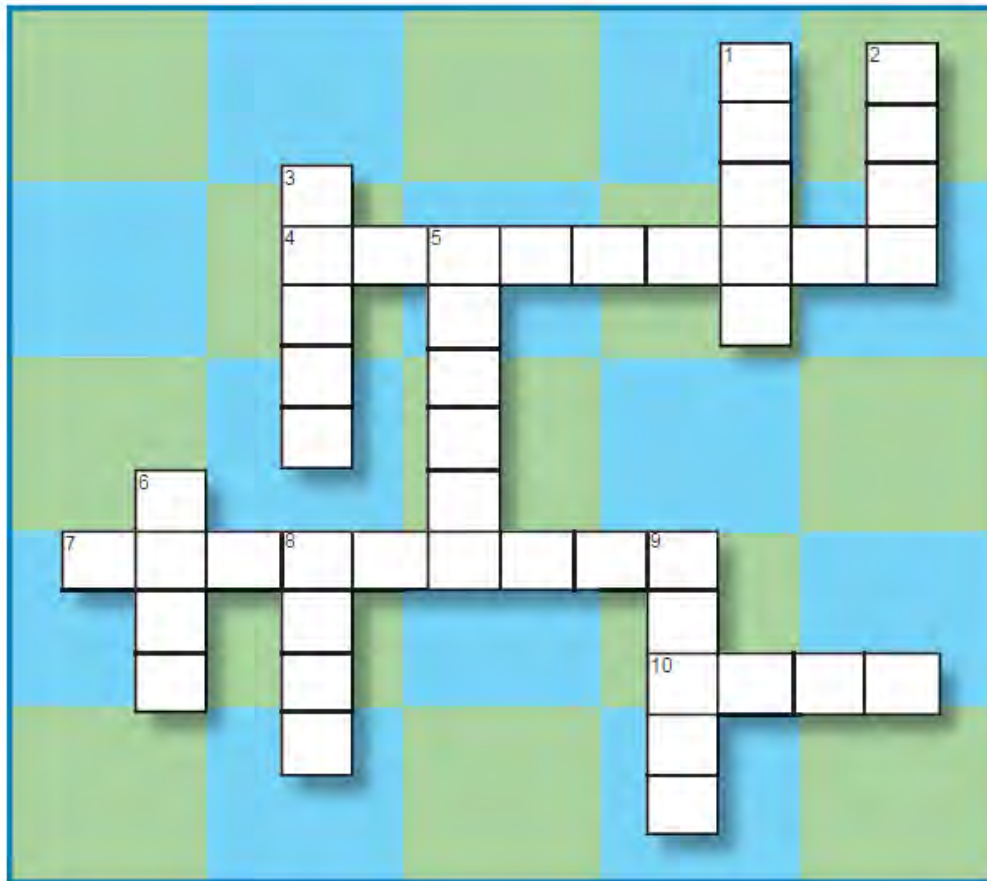

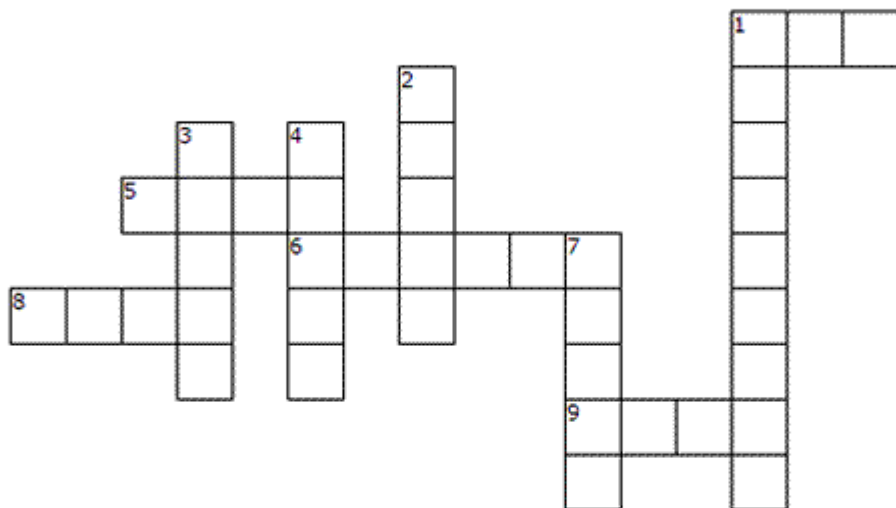
