Joseph's Colourful Coat


Make a colourful coat for Joseph to wear


Materials:


- Joseph and Coat template printed on cardstock
- A variety of different coloured pieces of paper


Instructions:

Make a Joseph Paper Doll


What you will need:

- Tan or White Card Stock (Heavy Paper)
- Crayons
- Markers or Coloured Pencils
- Scissors

Print, Cut, & Color

How to Make:

- 1. Print out the paper doll pattern and copy it onto heavy card stock.
- 2. Cut out the patterns.
- 3. Explain to your child that Joseph's father gave him a very colourful coat and that they should colour the paper doll's coat so that it is colourful. When they are finished help your children place the paper dolls on the stands so they will stand up.



Joseph and His Coat Paper Craft

Materials:

- printer
- paper
- scissors
- glue
- coloured pencils, crayons or Textas

Instructions:

- Print out the template of choice.
- Colour the pieces (as appropriate) and cut them out.
- Using the words as clues, glue the colourful patches onto the coat. When completed, the passage from Genesis 37:3 will be shown:

"Now Israel loved Joseph more than all his children, because he was the son of his old age. Also he made him a tunic of many colours."
