# JOSEPH INTERPRETS DREAMS



- 3 DOWN "Blessed are the \_\_\_\_\_ in heart, for they shall see God." **MATTHEW 5:8**
- 2 ACROSS "And it came to pass after these things that the \_\_\_\_\_ and the baker of the king of Egypt offended their lord, the king of Egypt." **GENESIS 40:1**
- 9 DOWN "So he put them in custody in the house of the captain of the guard, in the prison, the place where \_\_\_\_\_ was confined." **GENESIS 40:3**
- 4 ACROSS "Then the butler and the \_\_\_\_\_ of the king of Egypt, who were confined in the prison, dreamed a dream, both of them." **GENESIS 40:5**
- 8 DOWN "And they said to him, 'We each have \_\_\_\_\_ a dream, and there is no interpreter of it.' And Joseph said to them, 'Do not interpretations belong to God? Tell them to me, please.'" **GENESIS 40:8**
- 5 ACROSS The Pharaoh "restored the chief butler to his butlership again, and he placed the cup in Pharaoh's hand. But he hanged the chief baker, as Joseph had \_\_\_\_\_ to them." **GENESIS 40:21-22**
- 10 ACROSS "Yet the chief butler did not remember Joseph, but \_\_\_\_\_ him." **GENESIS 40:23**
- 6 DOWN "Then it came to pass, at the end of two full years that \_\_\_\_\_ had a dream." **GENESIS 41:1**
- 7 DOWN "Now it came to pass in the morning that his spirit was \_\_\_\_\_ and he sent and called for all the magicians of Egypt and all its wise men. And Pharaoh told them his dreams but there was no one who could interpret them for Pharaoh." **GENESIS 41:8**
- 1 DOWN "Then Pharaoh sent and called Joseph, and they brought him hastily out of the \_\_\_\_\_; and he shaved, changed his clothing, and came to Pharaoh." **GENESIS 41:14**
- 11 ACROSS After Joseph interpreted Pharaoh's dreams, Pharaoh "said to his servants, 'Can we find such a one as this, a man in whom is the Spirit of God?' Then Pharaoh said to Joseph, 'Inasmuch as \_\_\_\_\_ has shown you all this, there is no one as discerning and wise as you. " **GENESIS 41:38-39**
