MHAT DO I HAVES

- Faith: do you have faith in God? have you received salvation?

- Vocation: are you employed, or meaningfully engaged?
- Education: do you have a degree or diploma, or training in a particular field?
- Health: are you healthy, or if not, do you have access to care for your health?
- Rights: are you a citizen? do you have opportunity and protection of the law?
- Church: do you have pastors, access to resources and a church community?

WHO DOESN'T HAVE IT?

- Faith: who doesn't believe in Jesus? who isn't saved?
- Family: who doesn't have a spouse, kids, parents, siblings, grandparent/kids?
- Friends: who doesn't have many friends? who isn't part of your social group?
- Possessions: who doesn't have a home, a car, savings, food, or super?
- Vocation: who doesn't have a job, or purpose, or meaningful work?
- Education: who doesn't have access to education or the capacity to do it?
- Health: who is dealing with illness or incapacity, or can't access health care?
- Rights: who doesn't have citizenship, or opportunity, or protection in the law?
- Church: who doesn't have pastors, or resources, or a church community?

- Family: how can you be family to other believers, not just biological relatives?
