1. READ ROMANS 3:21-31

What does this description of God's actions tell us about His nature?

- 2. Paul refers to *the Law* many times in this short passage. In what ways do we still, as Christians, add religious performance to the sufficient work of Jesus on the cross?
- 2. According to Paul, how can humans be in relationship with such an awesome and holy God?
- 3. When Paul writes "God presented Christ as an atoning sacrifice", the question arises: Why did Jesus need to die? (couldn't God have done it another way?) Discuss.

4. How should we receive God's action through Jesus?
