



ROMANS 8:28-39

SUPPLEMENTARY QUESTIONS:

1. Romans 8:28 talks about God's ability to work in all things "for the good of those who love him".

Are there some situations in life where you have seen God work good out of difficulty?

2. Romans 8:29-30 is known as the "Golden Chain" of our assurance as Christians. Each part of the chain is vital in our unbreakable connection with our Maker. Discuss being *foreknown, predestined, called, justified* and *glorified*.

3. In V31-32 Paul summarises the appropriate response to God's incredible sacrifice and gift giving to us. What does it mean to you that *God is for you* to the point that he gave His Son?

4. In V33-34 Paul sees the Devil's many accusations and condemnations against us completely answered. How does Paul say this has been made

possible and how does this contribute to our freedom in Christ?

5. Consider the various images Paul uses to describe how inseparable our union with Christ is! How does letting this reality sink in to your bones help you deal with fear and anxiety today?
