READ John 13:34-35, John 17:19-24 and Romans 12:9-13.

Q: What did Jesus tell us to do? Can you pick out 3 reasons why we should do this?

Q: What are practical ways we can love one another?

READ Acts 2: 42-47

Q: How did the early church seek to build deeper connections?

Q: Which of these ways have you been involved in? Perhaps some people could share some examples where they have made deep connections. Which of these ways could you use to deepen relationships?
