LIFE GROUP STUDY – 28 JULY 2024

Warm-up: C S Lewis wrote a book about the 4 Greek words for love (Storge-affection, Philia – deep friendship love, Eros - sexual love and Agape – the love of God). Think of examples of how people use the word 'love' today? Which of the above types of love do they use the most?

Read: John 13:34-35 - Be love

- 1. What would the disciples have thought of when Jesus mentioned a new command (or commandment)? What did Jesus say was the greatest of these previous commandments? (Matt 24:36-37).
- 2. Imagine the context for these words of Jesus the Last Supper. What else had happened during that meal? Why would that have added weight to what Jesus said?
- 3. How had Jesus illustrated love and why would this have been challenging for the disciples (John 13:1-5)?
- 4. Jesus was giving a new command (commandment). Why was a new command needed?
- 5. What would be the outcome of Christians living out this new command (v35)? How did the early church illustrate this new way of living (Acts 2:44-47)?
- 6. Pastor Ian said that we can only give love if we experience love. How can we find this love to give to people (John 15:4-5)?
- 7. How can you 'Be Love' this week? How can you show love practically and to whom? Share this with others next week.
