


- Christina Greenwood will be regularly connecting with FEBC CEO Janet Cousens, with the aim to strengthen our partnership and develop new projects/opportunities for CBC to engage in FEBC "in country" work
- God continues to work in mighty ways through FEBC
- Many recent good news stories received from Yemen, Iraq and Pakistan, where the least reached are hearing the gospel and giving their lives to Christ
- Current funding from CBC is going towards the "BDKA" project in Indonesia. The acronym translates to "Adventures in Gods kingdom", consisting of short videos on YouTube with a presenter telling Bible stories. So far approximately 50 Christians have been trained, with about 40 of them already having the opportunity to share within school programs. If a child and/or family shows interest, then they are able to be linked with a local church. Praise God!

- Praise God for salvation of lives in Yemen and the work of the Holy Spirit
- Pray for ongoing opportunities for the team in Yemen to minister and have confidence despite challenging circumstances

- 3. That George Wilkinson got a good report from the ENT Specialist on Tuesday. The ear infection is healing well and he doesn't need to see him for another 3 weeks.
- 4. For the wonderful time the team have had in Rwanda. Praise God that both Pastor's Conferences were so well attended, the Graduation Service was such a special time of celebration, and the Church services that Pastor Sam spoke at went really well.
- 5. That Ray Earl and George & Jessie Chamberlain in St Basils are now COVID free and can have visitors again.
- 6. That Jimmy Hill has moved to a new Residential Facility that should be able to offer him better rehab. Continue to pray that Jimmy will be able to learn to stand and then walk.

Pray:

- 1. For Matthew Jurd who was badly injured in a surfing accident on Wednesday & is in St George Hospital. Praise God that two strangers were there to pull him from the surf & call the ambulance, and that the bleeding on his brain has stopped. Pray that there is no permanent damage to the nerves in his right eye which is completely swollen shut & the biggest concern at the moment. Pray for full hearing to return to his left ear as two bones in it have been fractured. The fractures in his skull are stable & should heal in 3-6 months. Pray for Rebecca, Madeleine, Harry & Jeremy to feel God's strength & comfort as they support Matthew.
- 2. For Peter Webb who is undergoing tests in Sutherland Hospital. He has been diagnosed with having cancer, but they don't yet know the source or the extent of it. Helen & the family have asked us to pray: That the doctors will have clarity & wisdom as they investigate; that the cancer will be treatable; and that Peter will recover quickly.
- 3. For 7 y.o. Joshua Lunney (son of Emma & Mark Lunney who are new to our CBC family) who is having chemotherapy for cancer in his eye next Thursday & Friday. He had this as a 2 year old and it has returned to his remaining eye.
- 4. For Rose Biradar who is undergoing tests as they have found a small cell in the lungs and are awaiting results to make sure it's not cancer. Once that is confirmed she will go on the list for a second heart transplant. Pray for Rose as she copes with the breathlessness she is experiencing, and for her family & her sister Jyosthna who is supporting everyone.
- 5. For Pastor Ian & Carolyn's daughter Melina who had her third surgery on Thursday & the surgeon was happy with how it went. Praise God that a drain wasn't needed and pray that this may be the final surgery she needs, and for full healing from the infection.
- 6. For healing for Robert Garnett's shoulder after his surgery on Monday. Pray that it heals well and that he copes with no driving for 6 weeks.
- 7. For Lissa Becker whose 94 year old mother is in hospital with pneumonia. Lissa has asked us to join her in praying for healing for her beloved mother. Thankfully Lissa was able to lead her to the Lord two months ago.
