*12<sup>th</sup> October 2025 – Finding Your One*  
*1 Corinthians 12:7-24*

## **Discussion Starter**

If you could instantly become amazing at one skill or talent, what would it be — and why?

## **Read 1 Corinthians 12:4-27**

What stands out to you, or what do you notice?  
What questions are raised for you?  
What challenges you?

## **Questions**

In verse 7, Paul says, "To each one the manifestation of the Spirit is given for the common good."

- What does this teach us about the purpose of spiritual gifts?
- How does this challenge our culture's focus on personal achievement or recognition?

In Verses 14-20 Paul talks about parts of the body feeling inferior ("Because I am not a hand...").

- What makes people in church life sometimes feel like their contribution doesn't matter?
- How can we help one another overcome that feeling?

In Verses 21-24, Paul now points to the opposite issue — parts that think they don't need others.

- What happens when certain roles or gifts dominate or overshadow others?
- How can humility and interdependence shape the way we serve?

In Verses 26-26, Paul now warns about division in the church and points to unity.

- What does this unity (the opposite of division) look like?
- How might we proactively guard against division?

In Verse 27 Paul now directs his words to us personally, "now you are the body of Christ..."

- What does this mean for you personally?
- What would it look for CBC if everyone served out of their spiritual gift?

## **Application**

- 1 Corinthians 12:4-11 contains a list of spiritual gifts. We also find spiritual gifts listed in Romans 12:3-8 and Ephesians 4:11-13.
  - Do you know your spiritual gift? If yes, how are you, or how might you use it to serve the church?
  - If you are not sure of what gift or gifts you might have, which ones resonate with you?
